Junior High Policies

- Lockers
 - Visit:
 - Once in the morning before RTI
 - Before Lunch
 - After Lunch
 - At end of day
- Hallway/Between Classes
 - 7th Graders: Teacher release students to help the traffic flow and congestion in the hall. Walk on the right side of the hallway. Manage your time to get to your destination.
- Restroom/Drink Breaks
 - You MUST have your agenda to use the RR, School Counselor, and get a drink
 - If you don't have your agenda, you don't go
 - No restroom privileges during RTI, during B and C lunch, or after 2:30
- Technology Use (Cell Phones, earbuds, etc.)
 - No cell phones at any point during the school day unless instructed to have/use them
 - EX: No cell phone use in the hallways, lunch, gym in the morning, etc.
- Food/Drink
 - Nothing but water and/or gatorade in the classrooms
 - Loss of these privileges at teacher's discretion
- Tardies
 - 2 tardies = a write up (school policy)
- Forgetting Supplies / Misbehavior
 - Strike system: Whether you allow students to go to their lockers or not, keep a paper trail of these incidents: ask students to sign and take ownership.
 - After Three = Incident write up
- No Bookbags in the classroom
