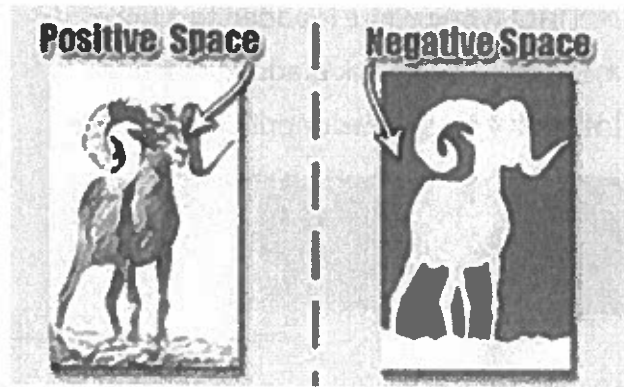

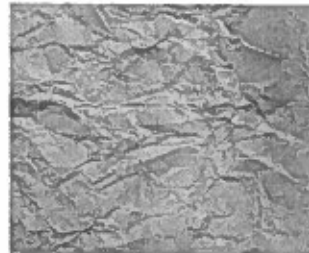
## SPACE

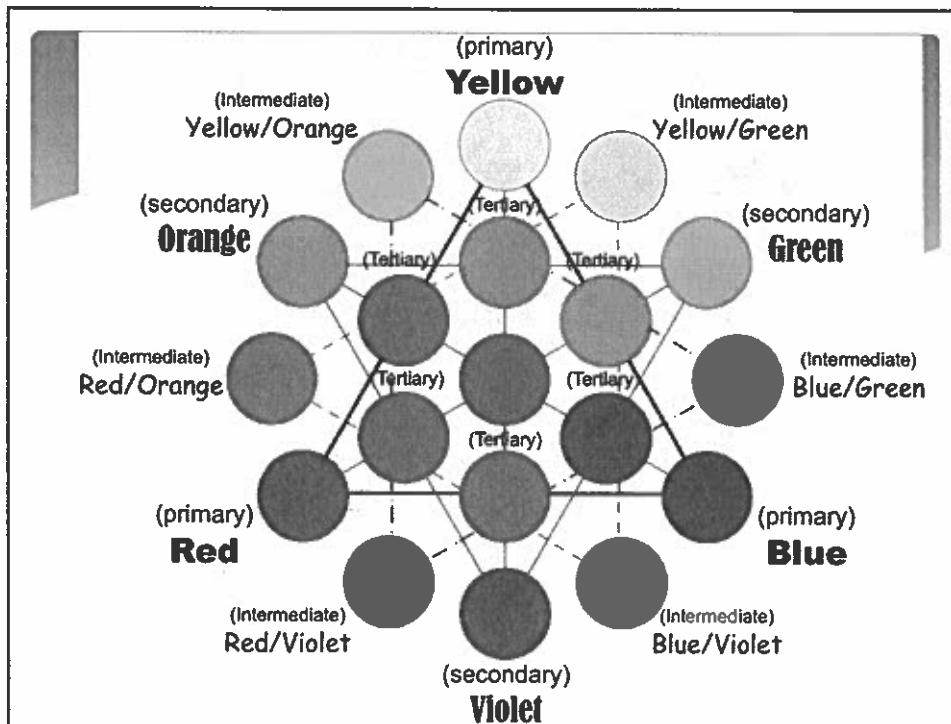
- \* the distance or area between, around, above, below, or within things.

- \* How things feel, or look as though they might feel if touched.






- \* Find images in magazines that are visual examples of the 7 elements of art.

- Rudolph Dirks



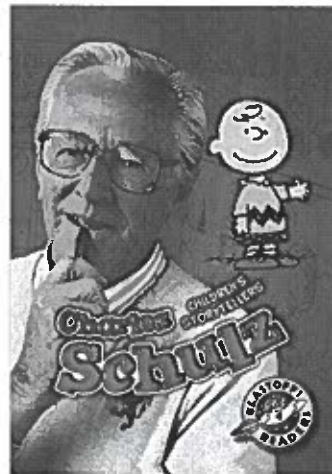

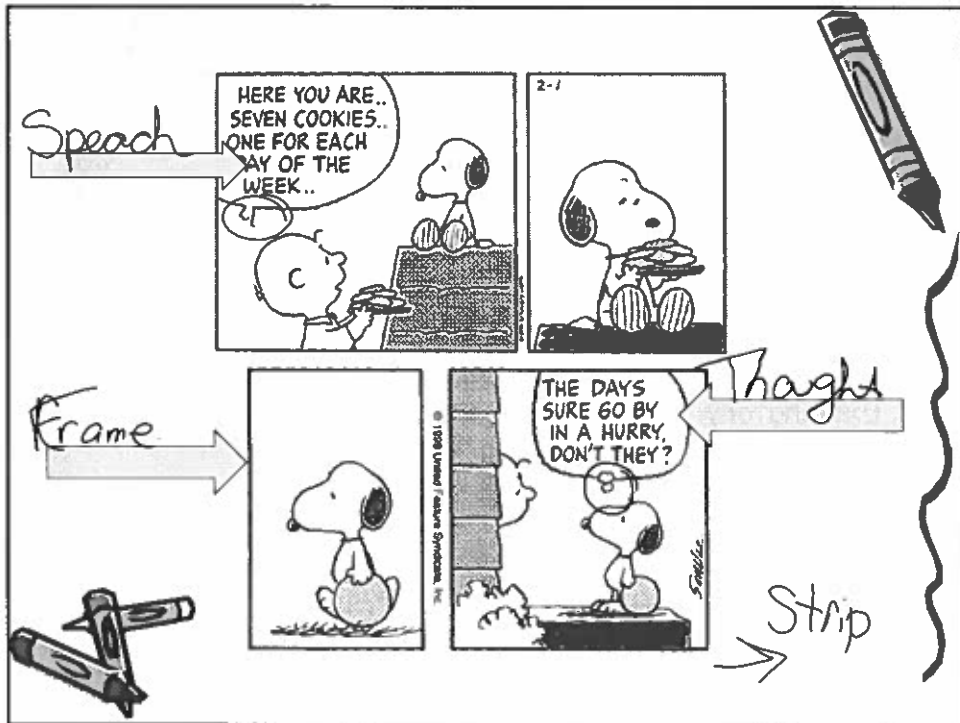

- creator of Peanuts cartoon.
- born in Minneapolis, Minnesota, on November 1922
- launched his comic strip *Peanuts* in 1950. Featuring hero Charlie Brown,
- over the years the strip would run in more than 2,000 newspapers and in many languages.
- Schultz died on February 12, 2000
